PPL-Shortlist

Before: Before starting the PPL training you will need a Student Pilot Licence and a medical evaluation. Soon after your first flights you must provide us with a copy of your Radio Communication Certificate / AFZ. We can assist you with the organization of the course to meet this requirement.

Duration of training: Depending on your schedule (and weather) we will set individual appointments. In general PPL training will take 8 to 12 months, and sometimes as little as 1-2 months.

Content: Theory - 9 subjects. You will receive all required material (printed or online version) to study the following subjects: Air Law, Human Performance and Limitations, Meteorology, Communication, Principles of Flight, Operational Procedures, Flight Performance & Planning; Aircraft General Knowledge, Navigation.

Flight Training: From Salzburg Airport, flying begins right away. Our aircraft is a modern, four-seat Diamond Star DA 40 TDI. We work with you to set appointments (or cancellation) according to your schedule and needs.

Our focus is called Upset Prevention Recovery Training or flight safety training – you will learn more during your PPL. Spins & More offers aerobatic training on a Super Decathlon aircraft. We also offer training for "unusual attitudes" which is not common in flight school practice. After you receive your PPL switching to UPRT or aerobatics training with flight instructors you already know is easy. Please let us know if you are interested.

Exam: After a preliminary examination at Spins & More you will take the theoretical exam in Vienna (ACG / Austro Control). This is followed by a practical skill test on the DA 40 in Salzburg. You may choose the Examiner yourself from a list. Good luck!
